Leader Instructions "Take Time" Family Lenten Game

Materials Needed

- Handout: Game board (print one per family)
- Buttons, tiny toys, or small pieces of construction paper to make a "marker" for each family member
- If using construction paper for markers, pencils or markers are also needed
- One die for each family

Talking Points

It would be helpful for a leader to introduce the activity with these points:


- Let's take a few moments to play a family game which will invite us to share some of the times of our everyday lives.
- Pick a token for each family member and then take turns moving through the game board.

Help the group along if they have any questions or get stuck.

Roll a die to determine the order of play. The lowest number goes first.
Each person—in turn—rolls the die to determine how many spaces to advance.
As each member lands on a space, she or he answers the question, completes the sentence, or follows the directions. All other players listen.
The game is finished when all players have reached the FINISH square and followed the directions.
