



Christmas ~ Jordan Schedule

Our celebration of the Birth, Circumcision and Baptism of Christ for 2011/2012.



Saturday, December 24 – Vigil of Christmas

- ⊕ 5:00 p.m., Christmas Eve Divine Liturgy – being prepared especially for families with young children, though everyone is welcome. This celebration will be under one hour.
- ⊕ 10:00 p.m., Christmas Eve Vigil and Divine Liturgy. Our usual Christmas Eve celebration. As usual, will be about 90 minutes in length.

Sunday, December 25 – Great Feast of the Nativity of Christ (Christmas)

- ⊕ 10:00 a.m., Christmas Day Divine Liturgy (commemoration of the visit of the three Magi as we continue to celebrate the Birth of Christ).

Monday, December 26 – Synaxis of the Mother of God & Ever-virgin Mary

- ⊕ 10:00 a.m., Festal Divine Liturgy (commemorating the Mother of God as we continue to celebrate the Birth of Christ).

Sunday, January 1 – Feast of the Circumcision of Christ; Feast of St Basil the Great

- ⊕ 10:00 a.m. Divine Liturgy

Thursday, January 5 – Vigil of the Baptism of Christ

- ⊕ 7:00 p.m., Vigil Divine Liturgy with the Great Blessing of Water

Sunday, January 8 – Sunday After Theophany

- ⊕ 10:00 a.m., Festal Divine Liturgy with the Great Blessing of Water as we continue to celebrate the Baptism of Christ in the Jordan.
