Craft: "Zacchaeus in the Tree"

Materials:

Small paper plate
Green tissue paper cut into 1-inch squares
Scissors,
Pencil with eraser end
White glue,
Tape
Wooden tongue depressor or popsicle stick,
Figures of Jesus and Zacchaeus,
Two wooden clothespins.

Directions:

Twist tissue around end of the pencil, dip into the glue and glue to the back of the plate.

Tape the tongue depressor/popsicle stick to the bottom of the plate.

Cut out the figures of Jesus and Zacchaeus. Glue to the clothespins.

Use the clothespins and tree to tell the story of Jesus and Zacchaeus.
