1. What did the son want from his dad and why did this make the dad sad?

The son wanted to leave his father. He thought he didn't need him anymore. He made a lot of bad choices, but he made one really good choice to go back to his father.

The father was sad because he loved his son and knew what was best for him. He knew that the boy still needed his father to guide him.

Just like the boy in the story, we will always need our heavenly Father to guide us to do what is right. Without Him we can lose our way too.

2. Do adults ever do things that are wrong or is it just kids?

We are all human! We all sin, but we are also all God's children and we need to try everyday to listen to the Holy Spirit which reminds us that we have done wrong and need to turn back to God. If they see their parents admitting that they have done wrong and working to do what is right, it will give them encouragement to do the same.
