APOSTLESHIP OF PRAYER, ST. JOSAPHAT CATHEDRAL, EDMONTON

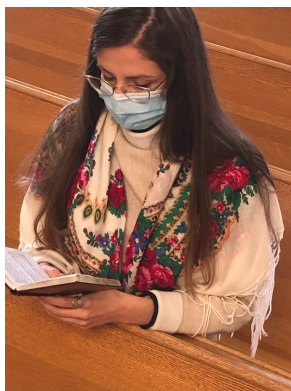
AGE: All ages.
