

If it is real, what does that mean for our faith? Our presenter, Ed Hecker, is a retired teacher who lives in Edmonton. LAY LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

A two-year program created to prepare individuals for ministry within the parish context. It includes independent online learning as well as in-person educational components. Participants will complete six 5-week courses online each year for two years. Upon completion, they receive a Certificate in Catholic Studies (CCS) from Newman Theological College each year. It is expected that parishes support candidates from their parish, spiritually and financially.

In the first year participants will be granted the certificate: Eastern Christian Traditions I which introduces the rich tradition of the Eastern Church. In the second year they will be granted the certificate: Eastern Christian Traditions II, which allows participants to choose a stream of study based on their area of interest (pastoral care or catechesis). Each Certificate consists of six online courses. Each course has ten lessons, spanning five weeks and will require approximately four hours of work per week.

Participants will also attend five additional in-person sessions during the year. Oct. 2, 2021, Nov. 20, 2021, Feb. 26, 2022, April 30, 2022, and May 14, 2022 (retreat). 2022-23 dates TBD

In-person participation is encouraged but, if travel is not possible, there will be an opportunity to attend these sessions via Zoom or other technological platforms.

PERMANENT DIACONATE PROGRAM

Like the Lay leadership this program begins with the Certificate in Eastern Christian Traditions I in the first year. In the second year, candidates will enroll in the Certificate of Theology (CTh) at Newman College which is comprised of ten undergraduate courses. They will also take a reading course on pastoral care, guided by their pastor. The Certificate in Eastern Christian Traditions I can be applied as an elective course in the Certificate of Theology. Courses are available in person or on-line. Following the completion of the Certificate of Theology, candidates will carry out an internship at their parish.

Also like the Lay Leadership program it is expected that parishes support candidates from their parish, spiritually and financially.

PERSONAL INTEREST, INDIVIDUAL COURSES

All of the courses that are available for the lay leadership and diaconate programs are open to the public. If you are interested in taking these courses for your own interest and not necessarily in taking part in either of the programs, you are welcome to register in any or all of the courses, directly through Newman College. You will be welcome to attend the first of the in-person session (Oct. 2, 2021) if you should so choose. You will need to express your desire to attend this session by emailing education@edmontoneparchy.com at least two weeks before the session.


