

LAY LEADERSHIP PROGRAM AND DIACONAL FORMATION

AGE: Adult

DESCRIPTION: Is God calling you? Year I (of a two-year program) in collaboration with Newman Theological College starts in September 2023. This program was created to prepare individuals for ministry within the parish context. It includes independent online learning as well as 5 in-person sessions. It is expected that the parishes will support candidates from their parish, spiritually and financially.

Each course consists of 10 online sessions, spanning 5 weeks, requiring some 4 hours of work per week (2 hours per lesson). No exams. Upon completion participants will be granted Certificates in Eastern Christian Studies I and II.

Year I - Certificate in Eastern Christian Traditions I - an introduction to the rich tradition of the Eastern Christian faith. Participants will explore their faith through Eastern Theology, Worship and Spirituality and the Holy Mysteries.

PERMANENT DIACONATE PROGRAM

Also like the Lay Leadership program it is expected that parishes support candidates from their parish, spiritually and financially.
