The 'ONLINE' part:

Monday - Thursday, August 9-12, either 10 am or 2 pm

The first portion of camp will be online (via Zoom) in the safety of your own homes. During our sessions we will play interactive games, work with other kids in our own age group to solve challenging quests and do crazy camp activities.

Thanks to our awesome one of a kind "CAMP KIT", we will build bird houses and learn about how Purple Martins live and work together as a community. We will also hand paint a Byzantine Icon of the Theotokos (Mary - the Mother of God) with a real iconographer.



So that we can accommodate more campers, we are running two simultaneous camps, each consisting of daily sessions from Monday to Thursday. You can choose the morning camp at 10 am, or the afternoon camp at 2 pm. Each session will take approximately one and a half hours.
