
# Venerable Titus the Wonderworker

From his youth Saint Titus the Wonderworker displayed zeal for the monastic life. He labored in asceticism in the IX century at the Studion Monastery near Constantinople. By his fasting, and meek disposition, Saint Titus gained the love of the brethren, and at their request he was ordained as a Hieromonk.

His soul was filled with fervent love for God and for his neighbor. As the Lord had said to His disciples, "My food is to do the will of him who sent me, and to accomplish his work" (John 4:34). So it was with Saint Titus. His food was to do the will of the heavenly Father in every way, and to utilize his life for the moral and spiritual building of his brethren (I Corinthians 3:9). Because of the purity of his soul and his virtuous life, God rewarded him with the gift of working miracles. Thus, he became the Spiritual Father of many laymen and monks who received benefit from his advice.

Saint Titus defended the Orthodox veneration of the Holy Icons during the Iconoclastic persecution, remaining steadfast in the Faith until the end of his life, then he departed to the Lord.


## 3 Days of Prayers for Peace with the Icon of the Protection of the Mother of God in our parish concludes today

### A Delicious Way to Support Ukrainian Newcomers

Cooking meals from their homeland helps refugees acclimate to their new lives in Canada

The Free Store for Ukrainian Newcomers was established in the spring of 2022, and it's had more than 6,000 visitors. The premise was simple; it would be a place where those fleeing the war in the Ukraine could find life's necessities as they adjusted to their new lives in Canada.

But what if the Free Store could also be a place for these Ukrainian refugees to sell their goods to the public?

A few months back, Ukraine's Kitchen by Free Store opened, and there were 300 orders made for Ukrainian goodies such as perogies, borscht, cabbage rolls and sweets. Free Store co-founder Jorgia Moore said that six people are currently working in the kitchen.

"They are in a place that's safe, they can speak the language that's familiar to them, and they are sharing the recipes that come from home," she said.

The Ukrainian cooks work with Indigenous chef Matthew Potts, and Moore said it's important that the newcomers recognize that they have found refuge on Treaty 6 Territory. With that in mind, Potts and the newcomers will soon create meals that mix Indigenous and Eastern European flavours.

Moore is four generations removed from her great-great grandparents who came to Canada. She's learned a lot from the food that the newcomers are making in the kitchen.

"I realized that a lot of the Ukrainian food we eat in Alberta is very old school," she said. That is, much of the Ukrainian recipes we're familiar with came to Canada during the great waves of immigration in the early 20th century. But, meanwhile, back in Ukraine itself, the food scene evolved.

So, the Ukrainian chefs at the Free Store are making things that are new to Moore, like the Eastern European take on croissants.


"I had never had them before, but was told they're very popular now back in Ukraine," she said.

If you'd like to try some of the fare from Ukraine's Kitchen, you can <u>order ahead</u> or visit the Free Store. As Moore points out, you can do double-duty to support Ukrainian refugees — go to the store and donate some goods, and then purchase some food from the kitchen.

Шість день перед Пасхою прибув Ісус у Витанію, де перебував Лазар, якого воскресив був з мертвих. Там, отже, справили йому вечерю, і Марта прислуговувала; а й Лазар був серед тих, які разом з ним посідали до столу. Марія ж узяла літру мира з щирого нарду, вельми дорогого, помазала ноги Ісуса й обтерла їх волоссям своїм; і наповнився дім пахощами мира. Каже тоді один з його учнів, Юда Іскаріотський, що мав його зрадити: «Чому не продано це миро за триста динаріїв і не роздано бідним?» Сказав же так не тому, що піклувався про бідних, але тому, що був злодій: із скарбнички, яку тримав при собі, крав те, що туди вкидувано. Тож Ісус промовив: «Лиши її. На день мого похорону зберегла вона те миро. Бідних матимете з собою повсякчас, мене ж матимете не завжди.» Тим часом дізналася сила народу, що він там, то й посходились – не тільки Ісуса ради, а й щоб побачити Лазаря, якого він з мертвих воскресив. Тоді первосвященики ухвалили і Лазаря

believing in Jesus. The next day the great crowd that had come to the festival heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem. So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet him, shouting, "Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord—the King of Israel!" Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it; as it is written: "Do not be afraid, daughter of Zion. Look, your king is coming, sitting on a donkey's colt!"

His disciples did not understand these things at first; but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things had been written of him and had been done to him. So the crowd that had been with him when he called Lazarus out of the tomb and raised him from the dead continued to testify. It was also because they heard that he had performed this sign that the crowd went to meet him.
